Principal's Message

'True faith is not a leap into the dark; it is a leap into the light' - Eric Metaxas.

Categorically we can say that faith begins where reason ends. Actually reason is the stepping stone to faith. When human mental power reaches its threshold, we turn to God. It is not helplessness but a hope in divine providence. God blessed man with intellect and gave him freedom to think, to discover, to discern and to act. It is not true what Jean- Paul Sartre propagates, 'we are thrown into the world...condemned to be free'. When critically analysed we can be aware of the fact that in divine providence we got a privilege to be born as free children of God.

Gabriel Honoré Marcel, the French philosopher, points out that there are two types of people - 'Man of Problem and Man of Mystery'. The Man of Problem, considers everything as PROBLEM and he always tries to solve it rationally. He may solve one problem but immediately another problem arises. But for the Man of Mystery, everything is a Mystery. He looks at the issue from the perspective of FAITH. Instead of solving the problem, he accepts it as Mystery relying on God's divine providence.

Faith is trusting in God's protection, as a little child puts his confidence and trust on his father unconditionally. It includes belief in the existence of god. It is closely associated with belief, trust, and reliance. It is not a blind acceptance but an experience of the loving care of the Almighty. It is an unconditional love between God and man. It is a trust in the God who says, "can a woman forget ' her nursing child, or lack compassion for the son of her womb? Even if 'she could forget' 'I will not 'forget you. Behold, I have inscribed you on the palm of my hand" (Isaiah 49:15).

We can live with a conviction that our God is a loving Father who loves us more than we love Him; He will not forsake me even if I betray Him; He will not let me go astray even when I abandon Him.

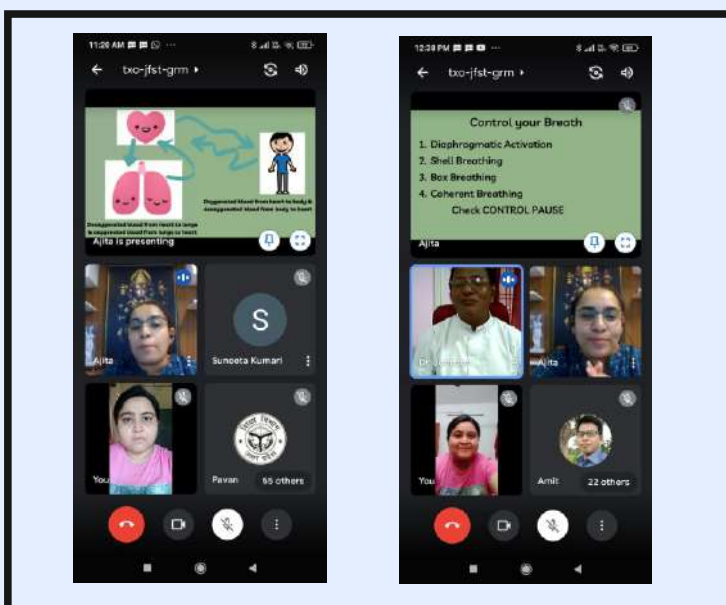

Birthday Celebrations of Dr. Pallavi Shrivastava

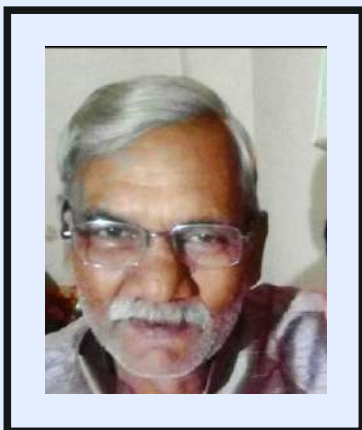
