Birthday Celebrations



Educating India: Innovative Teachers

India has a great tradition of attaching value to education, moulding young minds. We also have a culture of honouring our teachers and they have always been held in high respect. India has achieved rapid economics growth and development not just because of the investment in science and technology but more fundamentally in educating its masses. Every year, September 5 is celebrated as Teacher's Day to honour the gurus who shape the destiny of the nation by imparting knowledge, values and wisdom to the younger generation.

"Every day is different, every moment is different and no two classes or students are the same. When you keep thinking about that you become what you desire to be as a teacher." On the other hand, a teacher who works like a machine fails to recognise the students in front of them and take them for granted.

The growth in Information Communication Technology (ICT) and the disruptions during pandemic helped bring out innovative mindset of teachers and school leadership to the forefront. Teacher has become performer on stage and he needs all the paraphernalia of the media. "Teachers are becoming like film directors, they have to decide what scene has to be shown first and what scene has to be cut into while teaching and add a bit of background music too. Teaching is becoming a total performance rather then a ritual lecturing. They need to tune their personality to be a performer rather then a mere person who just transmits information through a lecture."

And indeed the 'performers' of the classroom drawn from such disciplines as physics, biology, art, coumputer science, social science, had one thing in common. They were ready to forego the tight boundaries of compartmentalized learning and go beyond the classroom to make their learning effective and engaging for students.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Teachers should be performers of the classroom where they need to integrate technology and other elements.
- Teachers should nurture the academic, mental and emotional quotient in children.
- Art integrated education helps in developing the 4 C's-Critical Thinking, Collaboration, Creativity and Communication.
- Use of more visual elements such as doodles, caricatures or cartoons can improve learning and behavioural outcomes.
- Teacher is not a sage on the stage. He or she must be friendly, democratic and consider students as equal.
- Breaking science into compartments fails to give a larger picture of how they complement each other.
